Pump House Point Resort Lost in Red Tape?

The Tasmanian National Parks Association is calling on the State Government to let Tasmanians know what is proposed for the mooted resort development at Pump House Point in the Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area (TWWHA).

‘It’s now over a year since the expressions for interest were called for and despite on-going rumors that a preferred developer has been selected the public is still in the dark,’ said Dr Campbell.

‘While bulldozers are pushing into the South West National Park to build a resort in a National Park that should never have been allowed to happen, we are still waiting to hear what is being discussed or proposed for Pump House Point.’

‘Although the likely developer was named in this year’s budget estimates hearings – no details have been made public.’

‘The TWWHA Management Plan states that overnight accommodation facilities should be located outside the WHA and we call on the Government to abide by this agreed position,’ Dr Campbell added.
